15 % Namibian VAT is included in daily rates as well as the Namibia Tourism Board (NTB) - Levy.

Arrival and departure days with no hunting will be charged according to the rate of a resting day.

Arrival and departure days with hunting planned or completed will be charged according to the rate of a full hunting day.

Included in the daily rates:

- v Services of a *licensed* hunting guide
- v Tracker and Skinner
- v Hunting vehicle
- v Field preparation of trophies
- v Delivery of trophies to local taxidermist or shipping agent
- v Full accommodation with catering and laundry service

Not included in the daily rates:

- v Cost per animal hunted
- v Hunting permits (a permit must be obtained from the Ministry of Environment and Tourism) 40€ for plains game, 40€ for Cheetah/Leopard
- v Rented rifle (€ 15 /day. Any ammunition will be separately charged)
- v All drinks
- v Gratuities
- v Export costs for trophies
- v Transfers from Windhoek airport to Hamakari and back (€ 200.00 per Trip, shared amongst passengers)
- v Transfers to other hunting areas or tourist attractions
€ 0,70 per kilometre (excluding Mon Desir and Eldorado)

Firearms and Ammunition:

- v Calibre 7×64 upwards, for Eland 8×68S, 9.3×64, .375 H+H, etc.
- v Import permits for fire arms and ammunition (up to 60 rounds) are available at the airport in Windhoek
- v Please note: Only ammunition specific to the firearm may be imported
- v Handguns and automatic rifles are prohibited

- v For abnormal trophies the full price will be charged

- v We recommend a comprehensive travel, medical, and accident insurance, as well as a baggage insurance which should also cover your rifle
- v We cannot be held reliable for possible losses, injuries, damages, accidents and delays

Reservations/Bookings:

We require a non-refundable deposit of €1000.00 per hunter and €500 per non-hunting companion. **The booking will only be confirmed when we have received this payment.** If the hunting trip does not take place within the running year/season the deposit is non-refundable. The deposit is, however, transferable to a substitute hunter.

Recommended necessities to bring along:

Sun protection cream/lotion (factor 30), sun glasses, insect repellent, binoculars, hat, torch and spare batteries. The months May to August can be very cold. It is advisable to pack some warm clothes for these months.

- v Hamakari is situated 1500m above sea level
- v Trophy hunting season is restricted by law in Namibia from 01 February to 30 November
- v Hamakari (12000 ha) is part of the Waterberg Conservancy
- v Mon Desir and Eldorado (7500 ha) are part of the Ovipuka Conservancy
